We have been involved in Haiti ministry approx. 13 years. God has opened many doors and given us many experiences. Our ministry has varied with: building projects, ministries in churches, being a host couple for incoming teams, working with missionaries on electrical projects, and teaching at a new technical school both electrical and sewing. Gary trains electricians in Illinois and thought he could do the same in Haiti. We asked around the mission compound how to get started and they introduced us to Lucner Pierre. He had the same vision and already put together a staff. So we could come along side of him and volunteer teach. It was an exciting moment to see God working!

In past four years we have enjoyed working with Haiti New Life Ministries (Ministry described below) as volunteer teachers. LeAnne's first time ever teaching she had 11 students and 9 sewing machines (which is a story too, how God provided for the sewing machines). She developed a curriculum and has had several projects. The first big project for the students was making quilted covers for the sewing machines. They exceeded her expectations. Gary had 3 two day seminars and also had 10-15 students. At the end of two weeks they were presented with an electrical certificate which meant everything to them.

Gary & LeAnne will continue to go to Haiti being grateful for the privilege to see lives changed. Our plans would be to go to Haiti twice a year as we have funds in our account. Thank you so much for helping us financially go to Haiti.
